Abstract: Alexandra Monteiro will give a short lecture about her research work at the University of Aveiro, concerning the study of atmospheric processes and the development and application of air quality models, with a special focus on the contribution to the decision-making process within environmental management. Various scales of atmospheric pollution problems are considered in the research developed – from local to global scale, with short- and long-term analysis – included in different scientific domains – physical and numerical modelling, meteorology and climatology, chemical and biological processes.
